### General Facility Information

- The PAC pool is 8 lanes and 25 meters.
- Our facility was finished at the end of 2015. There are photos attached that show the bathrooms, showers, changing areas and other parts of the facility. We also have a family bathroom/shower and a private bathroom that is specifically used by officials at meets.
- We use an SST Timing system, plungers, & CTS Infinity Starter.
- The city of Pocahontas provides our concession stand and does stock additional requested items for swim meets (ex: bananas) If you have specific requests for the concession stand, please let us know in advance and we will do our best to accommodate them.
- There are portable bleachers on both sides of the pool and deck space available for chairs.
- There is also a heated Therapy Pool that is only open to swimmers who are 16+, for this meet.
- There is a private meeting room, off the pool deck, that is used for hospitality, computers, official's meetings, coaches, etc.
- Our team has a Pro-Shop at every swim meet. It is stocked with well-priced items and offers additional value to families. We also plan on having a Winter Invite shirt and swim caps available for pre-order. We are also planning on having additional specialty Christmas swim items available for this meet.

  - The Callahan Motel (\$60+) Located in Walnut Ridge. Some rooms have small kitchens. – 15 minute drive
  - Lake Charles State Park – includes Campgrounds, RV, cabin, and Yurt rentals. (\$20-75+) – 30 minute drive
  - Davidsonville State park – includes Campgrounds (\$12-35) – 20 minute drive
  - Jonesboro is 45 minutes away and offers everything from Super 8 to the Hilton.
